NOTICE OF RACE

ALL TIMES GIVEN ARE BST

1. **Organising Authority:**
The organising authority is Royal Victoria Yacht Club.
2. **Place, Dates of Races:**
There shall be 1 day of racing sailed from The Royal Victoria Yacht Club, Fishbourne, Isle of Wight on Saturday 26 April 2008.
3. **Rules:**
Racing will take place under the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005-2008, the prescriptions of the RYA, the class rules, the sailing instructions of the event, and this Notice of Race.
4. **Fleets:**
There will be 3 fleets, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial and Laser Standard. Separate starts.
5. **Registration and entry:**
Entry and registration will be on the day from 0900 hrs, the entry fee is £10.
6. **Briefing:**
There will be a briefing for competitors at 1100 hrs.
7. **Schedule of Races:**
It is intended to hold 3 races, 2 races to count. One race will constitute a series.
The warning signal for first race will NOT be before 1155 hrs. High tide 1544 hrs, 4.1m.
8. **Prize giving:**
The prize giving will be held as soon as possible after the last race.
9. **Disclaimer of Liability:**
The safety of the boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/person in charge who must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. Neither the Sailing Instructions nor the inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/person in charge for the crew, the boat and her management. The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, howsoever caused, to the owner/person in charge or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/person in charge warrants the suitability of the boat for the race or races. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and competitors of their responsibilities.
10. **Insurance:**
Competitors are required to hold third party insurance for racing of at least £2,000,000.
11. **Safety Regulations:**
Life-jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy shall be worn by all competitors at all times whilst afloat. Wet suits and dry suits alone are not adequate personal buoyancy.
12. **Sailing Instructions:**
Sailing Instructions will be available on the day at registration.
